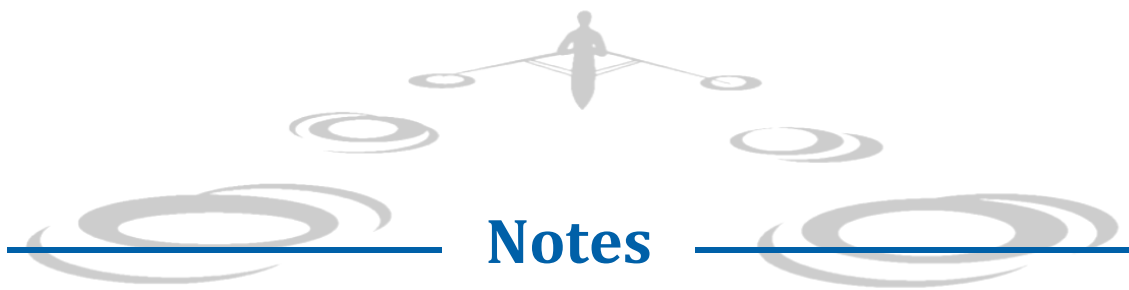

1. Entries will close before the advertised date (4<sup>th</sup> February) if the event is oversubscribed.
2. The draw will take place on the evening of Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> February. Please contact the Entries Secretary (via [warrington\\_regatta@hotmail.com](mailto:warrington_regatta@hotmail.com)) if you would like to attend in person, join via Skype or are interested in the process followed.
3. Crews may be moved categories if there are insufficient entries. Please state if this would be unacceptable for your entry.
4. Event documents, including the Safety Plan, Risk Assessment and Circulation Plan, will be published on the Warrington Rowing Club website (<http://warringtonrowing.org.uk/events/head-of-the-mersey/>).
5. The Head is divided into 6 divisions to help manage the event. Crews (including coxes) and equipment (including blades) cannot be used twice in the same or consecutive divisions.
6. The river may cover the landing stage. Therefore wellington boots or another form of water tolerant footwear may be needed.
7. The event is held under the British Rowing Rules of Racing. Competitors are specifically reminded of Rule 2-7-4 'Unsportsmanlike Behaviour' with particular regard to foul and abusive language. The likely outcome of such behaviour - regardless of whether it is directed at a person or overheard - is disqualification.
