

WRC REGATTA COVID-19 GUIDANCE

Pre-Regatta

- 1 Each attending club to nominate a single person as the contact for all communications, before, during and after the regatta.
- 2 The nominate person's name and contact details to be sent by email to the WRC safety adviser/Covid-19 officer prior to the regatta – mike.selway23@gmail.com
- 3 The nominated person (NP) to retain contact details for all their club members and anyone else attending on behalf of their club (GDPR prohibit WRC from gathering this information).
- 4 We would appreciate all attendees and club members taking part in the regatta to carry out their own self-assessment health check, prior to attending the regatta.

Regatta Day

- 1 Once on site, the attending club's vehicles will be directed to their designated area on the trailer park.
- 2 The NP to report to Registration (located in front of clubhouse) to confirm their presence, to notify any crew changes to those registered on BROE and to collect an envelope containing crew numbers, course map, race schedule and other information.
- 3 While on WRC site, we would encourage all members to keep a safe distance from others as far as possible and remain cautious of prolonged close contacts.
- 4 We encourage the wearing of face masks while using the toilets in the clubhouse where hand sanitisers and anti-viral sprays will be available, but only toilet paper should be used for wiping down surfaces.
- 5 Regular race briefings will be communicated via the PA system.
- 6 Crews will be called to the landing stage via the PA system.
- 7 Limited checks will be carried out on boats, but attending clubs are responsible for ensuring their boats are in a safe condition and have been sanitised (all rowers & clubs to provide their own sanitising supplies).
- 8 Landing stage marshals will be assisting and coordinating boats at the landing stage.
- 9 In case of rowers capsizing, launches will carry hand sanitisers and sterilising solutions.
- 10 WRC has a QR code displayed which all attendees are free to use.
- 11 It should be noted that the majority of the banks along the regatta course are public access and there is a public right of way through the middle of the WRC site.

After the Regatta

- 1 If a member from an attending club exhibits Covid-19 symptoms within two days of the regatta, they should inform their NP who should follow their club's Covid-19 guidance.
- 2 The NP should also send an email to the WRC safety adviser/Covid-19 officer to report the case and include details of any person that they were in close contact with for more than 15 minutes, other than their fellow club members.
- 3 If a member of WRC exhibits Covid-19 symptoms within two days of the regatta, they should follow WRC's Covid-19 guidance.
